



CARTHAGE INDUSTRY DAYS “TAKMIL”

Regulations

Art I : Date and place

“Carthage Industry Days “will take place in Tunis during the Carthage Film Festival on 02, 03, and 04th of November 2022.

Art II : Objectives

The JCC wishes to:

- Enable African and Arab filmmakers to submit their films, in the post-production phase, to the expertise of an international jury composed of 03 members.
- Provide material assistance for the completion of African and Arab films by providing post-production grants offered by the festival partners.
- Bring together filmmakers, producers, financiers, and distributors to create networking opportunities for three successive days.
- Promote the sharing of experiences and the exchange of expertise through panels and masterclasses between the various actors of Arab and African cinema and international partners.

Art III : Workshop description

Takmil is a post-production assistance workshop of the “Carthage Industry Days “section, organized by the JCC

The Workshop will take place during three (3) days in which the director of each film will be invited to defend his project before the jury.

Art IV : Films eligibility criteria

1. Directors must be of African or Arab nationality.
2. The submitted films must be in the post-production phase
3. Feature films or creative documentaries with a minimum duration of (60) minutes are eligible.
4. Rough Cuts of at least forty (40) minutes are accepted.
5. Copies submitted to the jury must be subtitled in English.
6. A director can only participate in the Takmil Workshop of the **Carthage Industry Days** with one project.
7. A producer can submit in Takmil Workshop with two projects maximum.

Art V : Selection procedures

The selection is under the Festival Management’s responsibility. A maximum of 10 projects between feature fiction and creative documentary will be selected.



Art VI : Film registration:

The deadline for film registration is **31/08/2022** (included).

To register, you need to:

- a) Complete the online pre-selection form for Takmil Workshop available on the JCC Website.
- b) Send a copy of the project to the JCC via Internet link **and** on DVD or Blu-Ray in 2 copies.
- c) The postal address for sending copies is as follows:

The JCC is not required to return the DVDs sent for selection even if the films are not selected.

Art VII : Selected films

The selected films will receive a notification on **September 30, 2022**. The selection of a film should remain confidential until the official announcement of the program by the JCC Management. The shipment cost from the films place of origin to the JCC Management is at the candidates 'expense.

Art VIII : Invitations and Reception

The JCC will cover the cost of air fare and the stay of the director or producer for 5 days / 4 nights.

Article IX : Post-Production grants and letter of commitment:

The list of grants and the amounts to be allocated will be published on the festival website: **Erreur ! Référence de lien hypertexte non valide.** before the closing date of registration.

- 1- Grants are awarded to the Producer(s) of the award-winning project in its entirety.
- 2- Once the film is finished, winning projects will be required to include the mandatory mention: « With the support of Carthage-Pro Takmil»; by including the JCC logo in the film's credits and in all information documents.
- 3- The director and his producer agree to reserve the Arab Premiere of the film for Arab films at the JCC on a mandatory basis.
- 4- The director and his producer agree to reserve the African Premiere of the film for the JCC for African films on a mandatory basis

Art X : Awards Ceremony :

Carthage Industry Days awards ceremony will take place at the end of the Takmil workshop.

Art XI : General rule

The participation in the **Carthage Industry Days** involves compliance with these rules and the JCC General Regulations. The JCC Management is the only authorized body to take decisions concerning any provision not included in the present Rules and / or their interpretation.
